




























David's Page


That covers the events that I managed to attend and enjoy with good input of fun from all who attended. Thanks again to all who made it a good season.





Retired Chief Inspector Nick Carter proudly collected a large trophy for the best club stand at the Southern Classic Bike Show at the Kempton Park Racecourse. Despite tough competition from other stands, one with a delightful display of Army bikes under camouflage netting and another with a witty bikers café built by the Guildford MCC, independent judges awarded the Historic Police Motorcycles stand first prize.

The soaring temperatures that weekend did not deter hundreds of bikers from queuing the length of the building in sizzling Sunbury to see an impressive display of two-wheelers of all types from all over the world, and to search the autojumble for that elusive part.


Beneath the theatrical glow of a blue lamp, five immaculate motorcycles, four of which had seen active service in British Police Forces, were placed in front of a backdrop of archive photographs of police bikes. Robin had brought his 1965 Triumph Twenty-One and John brought his Triumph Saint all the way from Wrexham, the first time it had been displayed in the South of England. We were indeed fortunate to have Fred's LE Velocette as the drawbar on his trailer suffered a stress fracture on the way with its coupling almost parting company with the rest of the trailer. However Fred's motorcycle and Drivers Licence survived unscathed. Dylan brought along his rare SEG BMW K100. A prototype CCM off-road bike in



Police trim completed the quintet of bikes, and attracted considerable attention, though the very observant noticed it was a mock-up that could not be ridden. Dave Bragg presented his model police bikes in the glass case at the front of the display. The whole ensemble produced something of interest to everyone, and we were all kept busy answering questions. After posing with the cup for photos, the big day was nearly over and we began to pack up. However, next day, we were all to be out in force at Mount Browne.



Classic 999 Show - 14th/15th July 2001





Over the weekend of 14th/15th July 2001 I attended the Classic 999 Show at RAF Cosford in Shropshire. I had visited Cosford on a number of occasions during the 1980's attending air displays and to help dismantle a Gloster Javelin for the Newark Aircraft Museum of which I was a member. Cosford is home to an excellent aircraft museum and large collection of missiles. I was therefore looking forward to going back but unsure about what to expect for a 999 show. I wasn't to be disappointed.

It was a family outing, accompanied by my wife and young son.. We had decided to camp out over the weekend taking two ex Police motorcycles, Ariel Leader and DMW Deemster on a trailer behind our old Bedford Dormobile. On arrival late on the Friday evening I was staggered to see a variety of tents, caravans, lorries, ambulances, fire engines etc spread across a large swathe of the airfield grassed area, we just had time before dark to get set up.

There had been a threat of rain but Saturday morning turned out to be bright with sunny periods if a little blustery, as it usually is on exposed airfields. From an early start, other exhibitors began arriving along with many visitors for the International Aircraft Modellers Rally that was also taking place. It was amazing to see the very large models flying around in particular types of aircraft such as the Vickers Wellington and De Havilland Mosquito of which no genuine full size aircraft grace our skies any longer The visitors car park soon began to swell with numbers. It was nice to see some familiar faces from other 999 shows in the past that gave a chance to chat about Police motorcycles, exchange addresses and explore the possibility of locating spares and Police trim equipment.

Sunday was a similar day. Again well attended by the public with a cavalcade around the airfield giving owners the chance to switch on blue lights and sirens etc.

In addition to the eight motorcycles lined up on display there was an interesting collection of ex Police cars, notably a Triumph Herald. Morris Minor and MGB all In Police livery. 


